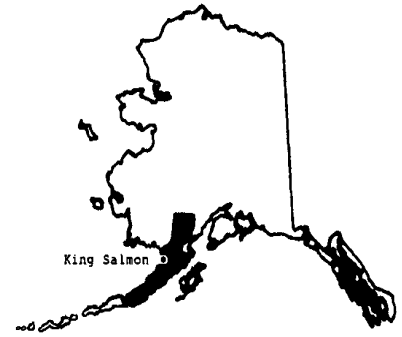

Dear Lake and Peninsula School District Stakeholder,

On October 13, 2011 myself and the Lake and Peninsula School Board reviewed our facility use policy. With facility requests on the rise we felt that a revised application (attached) was in order along with clarifying our procedures for non-school use of our facilities.

Some key criteria to consider for school use are as follows:

1. A completed application must be submitted seven days before the event
2. A certificate of insurance needs to be provided at least 24 hours before the event
3. If supervision or janitorial service is required, a fee may be imposed
4. When appropriate the Superintendent can waive fees and insurance requirements
5. Lake and Peninsula School District does not discriminate nor deny access to any activity because of race, religion, political affiliations, etc...

We work very hard at keep the politics out of the classroom and the focus on kids. One way we do this is to steer organizations that would like "classroom time" to go through our facility use procedure and offer their programs after school. This way students and parents have the choice to attend or not. Admittedly, this is not a perfect solution but to date it has helped keep our schools out of the political battles that surround the mine.

To close, our main commitment is to our communities, realizing that the schools are often the center point of most villages. School activities have the ultimate priority, followed by community events and then outside entities. The District and Borough are both committed to making our facilities available to all.
